BILLS

Bills are online only. Students access billing information in Buff Portal (<u>buffportal.colorado.edu</u>) once they are enrolled. Parents and other family members must get access from their students in order to view the bill. Students authorize payers in Buff Portal (<u>buffportal.colorado.edu</u>). STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN RATES

Gold Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) \$1,988² BuffCare Supplement \$225

All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder. Students must meet this requirement their first semester at CU Boulder and at the beginning of each academic year. Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours are required to complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline in order to avoid automatic enrollment in the SHIP along with a charge on the tuition bill. colorado.edu/health/insurance

PAYMENT PLANS (enrollment fee \$25)

Eligible students and authorized payers can pay the university bill over the course of the semester. Students can sign up each semester for payment plans in Buff Portal (<u>buffportal.colorado.edu</u>). Authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR TUITION & FEE REFUNDS
